COMPETITIONS

Although there will be no state competition in softball, there will be regional softball tournament at the M Fairview Sports Center in Woodbury.

TEAMS

Until we know the number of coaches and athletes who will participate in softball, we can't place athletes on teams. So, be sure to come to the first practice at 6 pm at Moreland Elementary School in West St Paul (217 Moreland Ave W) so we can get a count.

COACH REQUIREMENT: The softball team is required to have at least one Level II coach who manages the skills assessment tests, submits the information to SOMN by all deadlines, and provides overall management.

Special Olympics also requires a specific number of Level I coaches to athletes. The more the better.
